**G. New Business**

**1. Electrical Aggregation**

Marni Henert of Rock River Energy was in attendance to discuss the electric utility accounts for the Village of Stillman Valley. Rock River Energy provided those in attendance with a list of current rates available with six (6) suppliers. The most affordable rate is with Constellation which is the village’s current provider. President Waltrip and Attorney Henry have both reviewed the contracts offered by Rock River Energy to the Village of Stillman Valley and given their approval. Trustee Russell made a motion to accept the Rock River Energy aggregation contract for the next three (3) years beginning June 1, 2017 and to authorize President Waltrip to sign all documents pertaining to that agreement, Trustee Thibodeau seconded. The motion passed with four (4) “ayes”; zero (0) “nays”; two (2) “absent” Carlson & Palmer.

## **2. Village Clean Up Days**

President Waltrip reviewed the estimate received from Moring Disposal for the planned Village Clean Up Days. The cost for roll off clean up service from 6/10/2017 through 6/17/2017 excluding Sunday would be \$2,4314.75. To add all town curbside clean up service would add an additional \$3,459.75 to the cost. The board agreed to not include the all town curbside clean up service and to only have the roll off cleanup day service by voice vote.
